BEFORE USE

COMMODE BUCKET AND CLEANING

- 1. To remove the commode bucket, simply lift the toilet seat and fix the lid provided onto the bucket to avoid splashing. Carefully raise the bucket and dispose of the contents into a proper sluice or WC. Never use an open drain, sink or basin; this could cause a serious health risk. Clean out the residue with a suitable disinfectant and refit to the commode after use.
- 2. Simply wipe over the wood with a clean soft cloth, which will remove any dirt. The upholstery can be cleaned with a mild detergent.
