# MAXLITE OVERBED TILT-TOP TABLE

#### **BEFORE USE**

Please ensure you, and any persons that will assist you in its use, take the time to read, understand and follow the instructions in this user manual.

This table is intended to provide a flat, stable surface for activities and small tasks. When using as an overbed table, the gap measurement between the footboard/headboard and the table must be less than 60mm or greater than 318mm to minimise the risk of entrapment.


We strongly recommend that you keep the box and internal packaging for the duration of your warranty period.

# SAFETY GUIDELINES

- Do not exceed the maximum load of 25KG.
- Do not place hot objects directly onto the table.
- Beware of finger traps/pinch points when lifting, adjusting, and transporting the table.
- Ensure the floor surface supporting the table is level.
- Never sit or lean on the table.






# SETTING UP YOUR TABLE




1. Remove all components from the outer packaging and place them onto a level surface.




2. Insert Castors (G) into the front of the Table Base (E) and secure.



3. Insert Locking Castors (F) into the rear of Table Base (E) and secure.




4. Insert the Table Upright (C) into the Table Base (E) and secure.




5. Slide Tube Extension (D) on to Table Upright (C) Tube.

An audible "click" will confirm the tube is secure.




6. Insert Side Table (B) into the Table Upright(C) and secure with E-Clip (K)



7. Slide Table Top (A) onto Table Upright (C) tube.

An audible "click" will confirm the table top is secure.




Your MaxLite Adjustable Table is now ready to use.

# ADJUSTMENTS


## **HEIGHT ADJUSTMENT**

- 1. Twist the table knob anticlockwise to loosen Table Upright (C)
- 2. Lift or lower the Table Top (A) to the desired height.
- 3. Twist the table knob clockwise to secure.




# ANGLE ADJUSTMENT

- 1. Press & hold the Table Upright Lever.
- 2. Tilt Table Top (A) to the desired position.
- 3. Release the Table Upright Lever to secure.



# TABLE BASE ADJUSTMENT

- 1. Lift Table Base (E) clasp to unlock Table Base (E)
- 2. Pull Table Base (E) and extend to the desired length.
- 3. Close Table Base (E) clasp to secure.



# ACCESSORIES


# WALKING STICK/CANE HOLDER

#### ATTACHING

Insert walking stick/cane holder (M) into the edge of tabletop (A).

#### REMOVING

Pull walking stick/cane holder (M) away from tabletop (A).




# PHONE/TABLET HOLDER

#### ATTACHING

Hook phone/tablet holder (N) over the edge of the tabletop (A).

#### REMOVING

Unclip phone/tablet holder (N) from the edge of the tabletop (A).



# LOOKING AFTER YOUR ADJUSTABLE TABLE

#### CLEANING

To keep the table in optimal condition, it should be cleaned regularly with a damp cloth and/ or mild soap. Do not use abrasive cleaners/materials.

Dry the table thoroughly with a towel after cleaning.

Carry out regular inspections to keep the table in optimum condition.

## DISPOSAL


Disposal or recycling of the table should be completed through an approved distributor or disposal facility. (Local disposal & recycling regulations may apply)
