
The Vida 2-IN-1 commode is designed to assist individuals who experience difficulty in accessing or using a regular toilet.

It is the responsibility of the user and/or attendant to determine the safety and suitability of the commode for the intended environment.


SAFETY GUIDELINES

- Do not exceed the maximum user weight stated.
- Ensure all commode legs are at an equal height and are secure before using the commode.
- Periodically check the commode components are secure and free from wear and damage.

SETTING UP YOUR VIDA 2-IN1 COMMODE




 Remove all components from the outer packaging and place them onto a level surface.




2. Open the sides of the walker frame outwards.

An audible "click" will confirm the frame is secure.



3. Place the commode fixture onto the lower half of the walker frame, then secure using the pins provided.




4. Place the commode pot into position, then clip the seat and lid onto the rear frame.




FOLDING

- 1. Remove the commode components from the walker following the set-up instructions as a guide.
- 2. Press and hold down the centre pin to unlock the folding mechanism.
- 3. Fold the sides of the walker frame inwards to fold.



LEG HEIGHT ADJUSTMENT

- 1. Press and hold the spring button whilst adjusting the leg height.
- 2. Release the spring button when at the desired height.
 - Repeat for the remaining legs, ensuring they are at the same height before use.





MARNING! Ensure all legs are at an equal height and are secure before use.

LOOKING AFTER YOUR VIDA 2-IN-1 COMMODE

CLEANING

Clean and dry the commode regularly to avoid residue build up.

Use a damp sponge/cloth and mild soap to clean the commode, then dry thoroughly using a towel.

Do not use harsh substances to clean the commode as this can damage its components.

SANITISING

Use a mild disinfectant to clean the commode pan.

MAINTENANCE SCHEDULE

Your commode is made up of components which over time will become susceptible to wear and tear.

Perform regular inspections to ensure the commode operates as intended.
