SETTING UP YOUR SKYE FIRESIDE CHAIR

 **SUGGESTION** Chair/footstool legs are stored within the base of the seat/footstool and need to be removed before assembly.



1. Remove all fireside chair components from the outer packaging, then place them onto a level surface.

2. Insert the front and rear legs into the seat base.



3. Lower the backrest into the seat base fixture.



4. Lower the backrest wings into the backrest side fixture.





5. Place the seat cushion onto the seat base.
6. Move the fireside chair into a suitable position before use.

(ADDITIONAL) SETTING UP YOUR SKYE FOOTSTOOL



1. Insert the footstool legs into the footstool base.
2. Move the footstool into a suitable position before use.

 **WARNING!** Ensure all components are secure before using the fireside chair/stool.

 **SUGGESTION** If for any reason the fireside chair/stool needs to be disassembled, use the setup instructions as a guide to disassemble the chair/stool.

HOW TO USE YOUR FIRESIDE CHAIR

USER INSTRUCTIONS

CHAIR POSITIONING

Position the fireside chair on a flat, level surface before use.

If required, use non-slip mats to prevent slipping.

SITTING DOWN

Gradually move backwards, using the armrests for support if needed before lowering into the seat.

STANDING UP

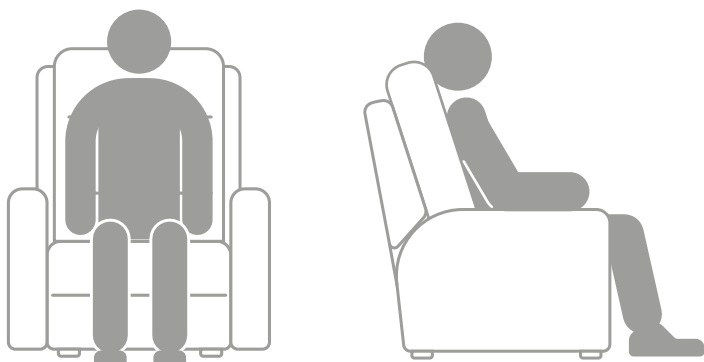
Use the armrests for support if needed before lifting upwards to leave the chair.

BODY POSITIONING

SITTING

Sit centrally within the chair and maintain a neutral posture.

Avoid leaning forwards and sideways.



OPTIONAL EXTRAS

SKYE FOOTSTOOL

The perfect addition to your fireside chair, providing you with additional storage space.

OPENING

Lift the cushion lid to open the footstool storage compartment.

CLOSING

Lower the cushion lid to close the footstool storage compartment.


MAX CARRY WEIGHT: 130KG

ARM & HEADREST COVERS

Keep your fireside chair looking as good as new with the additional arm & headrest covers.



LOOKING AFTER YOUR FIRESIDE CHAIR

 **WARNING!** Personal injury or fire damage can occur if the chair comes into direct contact with a heat source. (e.g., cigarette, heater)

We recommend that the user does not smoke whilst using the fireside chair however if the user wishes to do so, please adhere to the following safety guidelines:

- Never leave a cigarette unattended.
- Keep the ashtray a safe distance away from the fireside chair.
- Ensure the cigarette is extinguished before disposal.

UPHOLSTERY CARE

GENERAL CLEANING

1. Use a vacuum cleaner or soft brush to remove dust and grime from the chair's upholstery.

SPOT CLEANING


1. Blot the area with a clean absorbent cloth or sponge.
2. Pat dry with a towel or leave to air dry.

STUBBORN SPOT CLEANING

1. Apply shampoo foam to the area using a soft brush.
2. Use circular motions to cleanse the area.
3. Wait for the area to dry thoroughly.
4. Vacuum the area.

DEEP CLEANING

Contact a professional cleaning service if the chair becomes soiled.

 **WARNING!** Do not use solvent-based cleaners. Do not saturate the fireside chair in cleaning solution.

MAINTENANCE

Your fireside chair is made up of components which over time will become susceptible to wear and tear.

Knowing how to properly care and maintain your product will ensure it stays in showroom condition for years to come.

MAINTENANCE SCHEDULE

Carry out regular inspections to keep your fireside chair in optimum condition.

REPAIRS

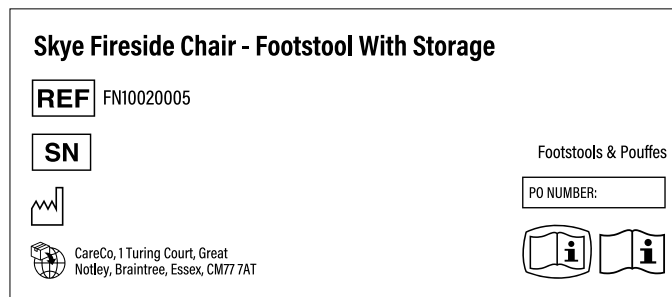
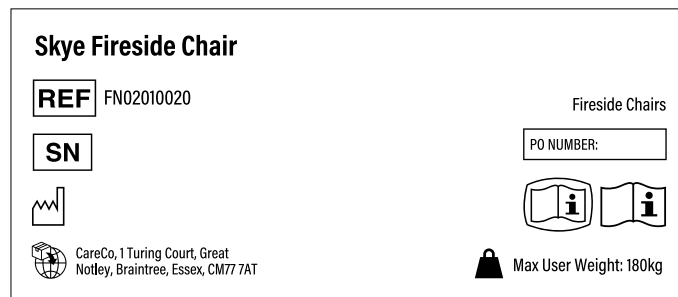

Unauthorized modifications and/or installation of unapproved 3rd party components and accessories can result in personal injury and product damage.



GENERAL WARNINGS

- Keep hands and feet away from possible pinch points.
- Do not stand on the chair at any time.
- Do not suddenly drop into the chair when sitting.
- This chair is suitable for indoor use only.
- Ensure the chair is on a flat, stable surface before use.
- When placing the chair near a fireplace, ensure it is at a safe distance to prevent overheating and contact with flame.
- Periodically check the chair for signs of damage/wear that could compromise safety.
- Do not exceed the maximum weight limit specified.
- When placing the chair on a hard surface, use non-slip mats to prevent slipping.
- Keep sharp objects away from the chair to prevent damage.
- Ensure the chair is properly assembled according to the assembly instructions provided.

EXPECTED LIFETIME

The Expected Lifetime is the estimated period of time for which the fireside chair is expected to function according to its intended use.

Various items such as weight capacity, user behaviour, and intensity of use can affect the expected lifetime.

WEIGHT CAPACITY:

If the user exceeds the weight limit specified, it may affect the fireside chair's expected lifetime.

USER BEHAVIOUR:

Using excessive force, rough handling or dropping components can significantly shorten the fireside chair's expected lifetime.

INTERNAL CONDITIONS:

Exposure to direct sunlight, humidity and extreme temperatures can impact the fireside chair over time. Ensure the chair is kept in a suitable environment to minimize these effects.

USAGE:

A fireside chair that is used daily may experience more wear and tear compared to a fireside chair that is used occasionally.

The expected lifetime for the fireside chair is 5 years providing the instructions and information within this user manual are followed.

Regular cleaning, lubrication of moving parts, and tightening of loose fixings will prevent premature wear and damage and extend the product's lifetime.

The expected lifetime is not related to the product warranty.

WARRANTY

If a component requires repair or replacement due to a specific manufacturing or material defect within its warranty period, it will be repaired or replaced free of charge by CareCo.

- **1-YEAR LIMITED WARRANTY**

Consumables are not covered under normal warranty circumstances unless they have clearly suffered excessive wear or damage as a direct result of a manufacturing defect.

The guarantee for the fireside chair is not transferable.

Parts that have been previously replaced that require subsequent repair or replacement due to manufacturing defects will be honoured for the remainder of the bathlifts warranty period.

Parts that have been purchased by the end user after the original warranty period has expired have a warranty period of 12 months.

CareCo is not responsible if the fireside chair requires repair or replacement as a direct result of:

- Changes or modifications made to the product that fall outside of the manufacturer's specifications
- The product not being serviced or maintained according to the manufacturer's recommendations contained in this user manual.
- Negligence, Accidental Damage, and Improper use.
- Repairs attempted before CareCo have been notified.
- The product being purposely damaged or mistreated.

In the unlikely event that this product is recalled, CareCo will notify the user.
